Foundation to Agility: This foundation class teaches focus, recall, ability to ignore distractions and building drive. Some introduction to obstacles is included in class work. Class is taught with positive reinforcement ONLY. Please bring a crate, clicker and plenty of treats and/or toys to the first class. A mat or cushion, big enough for the dog to lay comfortably on, will be needed also. Prerequisite: 4 months of age
