TRIAL REGULATIONS

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARY'S OFFICE, by 11:59PM, Thursday, December 31, 2020, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted. Make check payable to YABTC. Canadian exhibitors must have fees payable in US Funds.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted.

OVERNIGHT deliveries requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 is to be collected on the first entry only for each dog, each day. An Event Service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the show giving Club & paid to the AKC. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian/the Judge, or barred from competing by action of the Trial Committee.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE AN HOUR PRIOR TO THEIR RING TIME. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be held on leash in hand except when being judged.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE RETURNED if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, & no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE & no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial or top awards of a breed.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The trial-giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged. **Everyone is asked to clean up after their own dog.**

Transfers/Move-Ups: Any requests for transfers or move-ups prior to the trial weekend must be received by the Trial Secretary one-half hour prior to the start of each trial.

Any requests for transfers or move-ups between Trial 1 & Trial 2 on Saturday, must be received by the Trial Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of Trial 2. Any requests for transfers or move-ups between Trial 2 on Saturday & the Sunday Trials, must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last dog completes the respective Trial on Saturday or 30 minutes prior to the start of the Trial on Sunday.

RAE & RACH Exhibitors: When entering Advanced B & Excellent B for RAE qualifying scores, indicate on the entry form by checking the line "RAE" if you want to enter the trial **only** if you can get into both Advanced B & Excellent B. If you do so & if one or both of the classes has already filled, your entry w/fees will be returned. If you enter Advanced B & Excellent B as your classes & have not checked the line RAE on the entry form, & if one of the classes has already filled, your entry will be accepted for the class that has not filled & your entry fee for the class that has filled, will be returned.

When entering Advanced B, Excellent B, & Master for RACH qualifying scores, indicate on the entry form by checking the line "RACH" if you want to enter the trial **only** if you can get into Advanced B, Excellent B, & Master. If you do so & if one or more of the classes has already filled, your entry w/fees will be returned. If you enter Advanced B, Excellent B, & Master as your classes & have not checked RACH Entry on the entry form, & if one of the classes has already filled, your entry will be accepted for the classes that have not filled & your entry fee for the class that has filled will be returned. The Trial Secretary will maintain a wait list for RAE & RACH entries once class limits have been reached. Should any entries be withdrawn prior to the trial closing date thus creating an opening, exhibitor(s) will be notified.

Jump Heights: Jump heights are required to be specified on your entry form. Running order will be arranged in order by the height specified. Handlers w/multiple entries in the same class & w/the same jump height will be accommodated.

Jump heights will be from low to high in the first trials and high to low in the second trials.

Rally Team Competition: For the non-regular Rally Team Competition, any of the regular rally class levels may be offered. The Rally Team Competition will be for teams of any four dogs that are eligible under these Regulations. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required; however, the same four dogs will perform all of the signs. No dog may be entered on more than one team. There is a total possible score of 400 points for each team. All team members will run the course individually, with the team time running continuously. Time will start when the judge gives the first member of the team the forward command from the "Start" sign. The subsequent dog for each team starts when the previous handler for the team passes the "Finish" sign without an additional command of "Forward" by the judge. Timing for each team will begin when the judge commands the first handler in the team to begin with the command "Forward" and will stop when the fourth handler from the team passes the finish sign.

Scoring: All signs will be counted with a point value. The maximum point value that, can be deducted at any one sign, will be 10 points. It is possible for a team to receive a negative score.
