TRIAL REGULATIONS

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARY'S OFFICE, by 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, October 13, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted. Make check payable to YOUNGSTOWN ALL BREED TRAINING CLUB INC. (Y.A.B.T.C.). Canadian exhibitors must have fees payable in US Funds Visa, Mastercard & Discover Card accepted with a \$3.00 fee per each use.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 is to be collected **on the first entry only for each dog, each day. An Event Service fee of \$3.00** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competing by action of the Trial Committee.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE ANY TIME PRIOR to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be held on leash in hand except when being judged.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE RETURNED if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

NO REFUND ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents and employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES and a judging program will be made as soon as possible after entries close. Should such acknowledgment not be received within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary 330-718-0957

BITCHES WHO COME IN SEASON after the closing date may have their entry fees refunded less \$5.00 per entry upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than 10 am the day of the Trial.

WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial or top awards of a breed.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED at the Trial or they become the property of the Youngstown All Breed Training Club, Inc. None will be mailed.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring. All handlers are asked to clean up after their own dog.

*** DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE ***

From West: Take I-76 east to Bailey Road exit. Turn south (right) onto Bailey. Follow Bailey to Mahoning Ave. (approx. 1/4 mile). Turn east (left) onto Mahoning Ave. Trial site is one mile on right hand side directly across from Carter Lumber.

From East: Take I-80 west which will merge with I-76 west. Proceed two miles after the merger to the Bailey Road exit. Turn south (left) onto Bailey. Follow Bailey to Mahoning Ave. (approx. 1/4 mile). Turn east (left) onto Mahoning Ave. Trial site is one mile on right hand side directly across from Carter Lumber.

From Ohio Turnpike: Take turnpike to exit 218 [(Niles), formerly known as exit 15]. At exit follow signs to Mahoning Ave. When reaching Mahoning Ave. proceed on Mahoning Ave. west, at light (Rt. 45) continue west on Mahoning Ave. The show site is located on the left hand side after crossing the railroad tracks, directly across from Carter Lumber.

Or at exit 218 you can take I-76 west (Akron) to Bailey road. Turn south (left) onto Bailey Road. Follow Bailey Road to Mahoning Ave. (approx. 1/4 mile). Turn east (left) onto Mahoning Ave. Trial site is one mile on right hand side directly across from Carter Lumber.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under the "AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines". I (we) agree that the club holding this show, obedience trial and/or agility trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. - The following categories or dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
