Directions to Show Site

All: Take Bailey Road and I-80 exit. Go South on Bailey Road to Mahoning Avenue. Turn West (Right) onto Mahoning. YABTC is located on the right across from the blue water tower.

Set Up: You may set up crates for your dogs on Thursday evening from 5:30-7:00 p.m. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the site will be open at 7 a.m. If you are using x-pens, please be sure that they are no larger than a crate needed for your dogs. You will need a tarp or pad under the crates. Come in the front or side doors. Crating areas will be indicated by taped lines. There is plenty of room.
