**Refunds:** No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be  
completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of nature, public  
emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of  
the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a  
dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from  
competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season and injured  
dogs will be awarded a refund (with Veterinary Certificate).

### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered  
with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of  
a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible  
for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate.  
Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible. Bitches in season,  
aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity,  
injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance, are not  
eligible to participate.

**Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their  
dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and  
have appropriate vaccinations.** Proof of rabies vaccination required by state law.

**Friday:** Excellent A, B, Preferred Standard, JWW, FAST; Open and Preferred Standard, JWW, FAST  
Novice, A, B, Preferred Standard, JWW, FAST

**Saturday and Sunday:** Excellent A, B, Preferred Standard and JWW; Open and Preferred Standard and JWW; Novice, A, B, Preferred Standard and JWW

**Running Order** *Friday:* Excellent JWW, STD, FAST. Open FAST, Novice FAST, Open STD followed by Novice STD. Open JWW followed by Novice JWW. *Saturday & Sunday:* Excellent JWW, Excellent STD, Open STD, Novice STD, Open JWW, Novice JWW. *Classes will run small to large all three days.*

**Entry Fees:** \$23 for first entry per dog; \$12 second entry fee per dog; FAST \$12 (includes \$3 AKC recording fee per run). Make checks payable to YABTC.

**A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.**

**Show Conditions** Indoors on agility matting. Ring is 100x100. One ring trial with 330 runs per day.

**Course familiarization:** There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial. Handlers will walk the course without dogs. **Electronic Timers will be used in these trials.**

**Liability:** Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and its agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

#### **Prizes and Awards**

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH bars and MACH rosettes will be awarded for all MACH titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

#### **AKC Clothing Policy**

Advertising is not allowed in the AKC agility ring on the clothing worn by an exhibitor or ring crew staff, such as, "train at Joe's Dog School," or "eat at Joe's Diner." **Club shirts may be worn.** Writing on clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. **Clothing must not display the name of a person or a person's dog or their titles.** If a dog food logo is worn, it must not be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial. A picture of the exhibitor's dog may be worn.

**Crating:** Please conserve space as much as you can. If you are running in Excellent only, consolidate your space to make room for Open and Novice handlers. Please use a tarp/ground cover under your crates.

**From South:** Take I-77 or I-71 N toward Cleveland. Exit onto I-76 East toward Akron. Take I-80 toward Youngstown and NYC. Take 11 south. Exit on Route 46. Turn left (South) towards Columbiana. Turn right (west) at Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Huntington Bank.)

**From West:** Take I-80 East to 11 South. Exit 11 at the Route 46 exit. Turn left (south) to Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Huntington Bank.)

Or take I-76 East to Route 14. Turn right onto 14 and proceed through Deerfield and Salem on 14. Show site will be on your right in Washingtonville, just before Sky Bank.

**From East:** Take I-76 west toward Ohio. Exit at Route 7 (second exit in Ohio). Go south (toward North Lima) on 7. Turn right at Route 164. Take 164 South to Route 14. Turn right onto 14. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-b-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
