## Classes Offered

**Entry Fee:** \$23 for first entry per dog per day (includes \$3 AKC recording fee); \$12 second entry fee per dog per day (includes \$3 AKC recording fee).

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

**Show Conditions** Indoors on thick rubber matting. Ring is 100x100. One ring trial with 330 runs per day.

**Course familiarization:** There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial. Handlers will walk the course without dogs. **Electronic Timers will be used in these trials.**

All dogs without official AKC Jump Height Cards must be measured prior to their first runs. See the complete rules and regulations for agility trials at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org)

**Refunds:** No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund (with Veterinary Certificate).

### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

**Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination required by state law.**

**Liability:** Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and its agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

### **Prizes and Awards**

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH bars and MACH rosettes will be awarded for all MACH titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

### **AKC Clothing Policy**

Advertising is not allowed in the AKC agility ring on the clothing worn by an exhibitor or ring crew staff, such as, "train at Joe's Dog School," or "eat at Joe's Diner." **Club shirts may be worn.** Writing on clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. **Clothing must not display the name of a person or a person's dog or their titles.** If a dog food logo is worn, it must not be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial. A picture of the exhibitor's dog may be worn.

### **Running Order**

*Saturday and Sunday*

Excellent JWW followed by Excellent STD. Open STD followed by Novice STD. Open JWW followed by Novice JWW. Classes will run small to large both days.

### **Directions to Show Site**

**From South:** Take I-77 or I-71 N toward Cleveland. Exit onto I-76 East toward Akron. Take I-80 toward Youngstown and NYC. Take 11 south. Exit on Route 46. Turn left (South) towards Columbiana. Turn right (west) at Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Huntington Bank.)

**From West:** Take I-80 East to 11 South. Exit 11 at the Route 46 exit. Turn left (south) to Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Huntington Bank.)

Or take I-76 East to Route 14. Turn right onto 14 and proceed through Deerfield and Salem on 14. Show site will be on your right in Washingtonville, just before Huntington Bank.

**From East:** Take I-76 west toward Ohio. Exit at Route 7 (second exit in Ohio). Go south (toward North Lima) on 7. Turn right at Route 164. Take 164 South to Route 14. Turn right onto 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Huntington Bank.)

**From North:** 11 South to Route 46 exit. Turn left toward Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Huntington Bank.)

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
