Ariel also won the DC ISIS trophy for the highest scoring All Breed Vet. This was especially sweet as Isis was Ariel's GRANDMA!!!

More frosting on the cake. Ariel also won the Ridgelea trophy for the highest scoring RR for the weekend. Dan & Vilma O'Neill were "stunned" when Veteran Ariel won the breed on Sunday defeating 12 YOUNGER Ridgebacks. Awesome for an old lady.

PS: No real bunnies were harmed during the running for the CATs. White plastic bags are substituted.

More from Dr.Dan and Rev. Vilma O'Neill

Ariel is the first & only Lure Courser 10; a record breaking title. She is also the number ONE Lifetime ALL BREED courser. In the more than 20 years of AKC coursing Ariel is the # 1 Dual Champion sighthound and the #1 All Breed in the history of AKC. LCX 10 means a dog has won 450 CHAMPIONSHIP points past the Championship !!!

Ariel broke her OWN record of LCX 9. The closest any other hound has achieved is LCX 7. Ariel is also accomplished in the show ring! She is MBIF,Grand Ch, Can.Ch. Diamond's Ariel of Le Creme,MC, LCX 10, FCh, CGC, TDI TT.

Her mother, TEMPEST was the # 1 AKC All Breed Sighthound in 2002. She was the first and only National Lure Coursing Champion. MBIF, NFC,DC,Can Ch, Diamond's Eye of the Storm, CD,RN,MC,LCX3,CGC,TDI,ROM

Good DNA will "take you far." say owner/breeders Dr. Dan O'Neill & Rev. Vilma O'Neill. Ariel's father was the famous MBISS,BIS,Ch. Kwetu's Luke Blackburn owned by Bill Sahloff & Mike Szabo.

Ariel was born and bred on a small former dairy farm in the heartland of Ohio. She can leave the farm and go to the "Big Dance." She also has the record of being the breed finalist 3 times at the AKC National Lure Coursing Championship.

She has 3 daughters who are also Dual Champions. Kayla, Reine & Sojie, Daughter Sheba is also a FC. Champions come from champions, Beauty begets beauty, speed begets speed and type begets type. Daughter Reine won the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of American's national coursing in 2012 and Sheba won it in 2013.

Ariel won the breed (a major) May 18 over young dogs (including 2 of her daughters) at the Northcoast Coursing club trial in Austintown, Ohio. No bitch like an old bitch !

In all, 52 dogs ran for the CAT title, 15 ran for the Junior Courser title and 67 sight hounds ran for Lure Coursing championship points.

Judges were Roger & Joyce Katona from Chesterland, Ohio and Dr. Dan & Rev. Vilma O'Neill.

A prize was given to the participant who traveled; the farthest and it went to Laurie Rodgers from New Jersey.

It is very sad time for those who knew Bonnie Nichols. "Shelby", CH Nickolai Yeanty Vermillion, was one of Bonnie's favorite Borzoi's. After Bonnie's sudden passing in 2012, Shelby and her kennel mate Scotty, now GCH Nickolai Olovo Grindalyx, came to live with me and the LegendHold Collies.

Shelby had very little interest in anyone but Bonnie even when Bonnie was with us, though she tolerated me working with her when Bonnie went out of town the few times she did out of state shows and the few times I puppy sat the kennel for her.

Shelby didn't really want to be with me, but tolerated my brushing and clipping and general attempts to keep her happy with cookies and treats. Shelby tolerated the collies, but she missed Bonnie terribly.

Shelby turned 14 years old in February, an incredibly old age for a large Borzoi, but her health had been failing since Christmas. Finally, like many giant breeds, her back gave out and she became paralyzed from the shoulders back and refused to eat. Shelby was helped across the bridge on Mother's day.

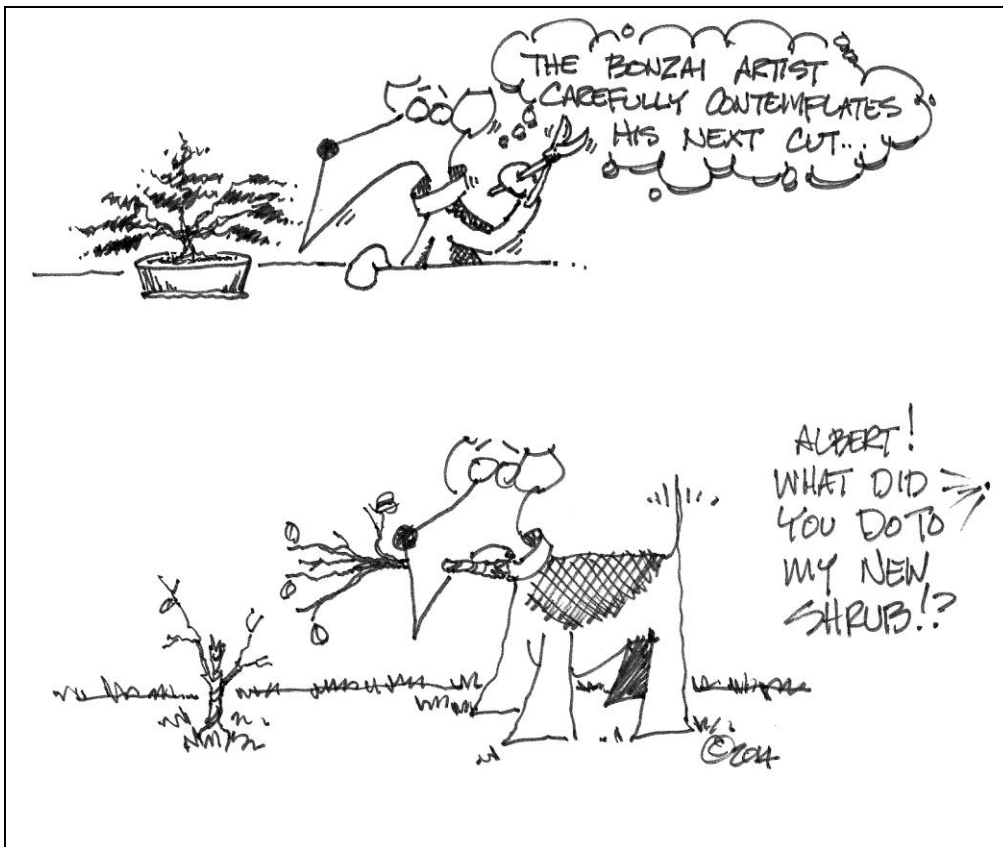

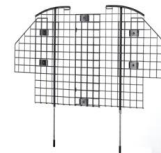
