



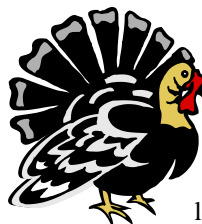

For the first time in its long history, YABTC held AKC agility trials in its own training center this past October 3-5, 2014. After our prior home was constructed and the AKC ring size regulations were changed, we were not able to sustain the agility trials at the old building due to the limited size of the building.

The October trials averaged about 270 runs per day and generated a return which will benefit all club members and support all club programs.

In addition, many exhibitors expressed an interest in joining our club, taking classes, and even instructing; all of which will help make our programs better and our club stronger.

YABTC and the agility committee would like to thank all club members who worked at the trials; and, would especially like to thank those members who worked and were not also exhibitors, and there were many. Two big concerns going into the trials concerned parking and food, and the club members in charge of the same did an outstanding job. The kitchen volunteers prepared a buffet the likes of which is never seen on the agility circuit and which rivaled the Mother's Day buffet at your favorite restaurant. In gratitude, exhibitors generously donated to our club. Through the efforts of our parking volunteers, parking became a non-issue.

Exhibitors were very impressed with our new facility and went out of their way to compliment club members. Most notably, exhibitors liked the facility itself, the floor system, the accessibility of the new building to the Turnpike and major highway systems, and the food. 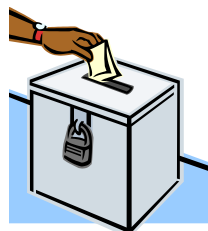
Debbie Harper - (Incumbent Recording Secretary)

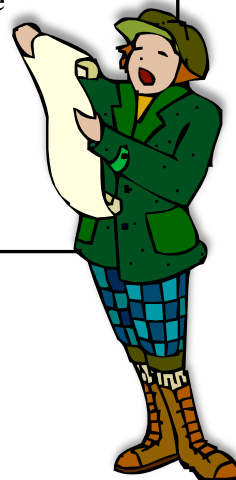
