Volunteers Needed!

June Agility Trial is coming!

(Worker herder correction from last issue!)



Youngstown All Breed Training Club will be hosting its next agility trial at the Wellness Center in Niles on Saturday and Sunday, June 20 And 21.

The agility trial committee works very hard to put on four trials a year at the “Well”. A few days prior to the trial, the committee along with several other faithful members, load Mike Coates’ trailer with ring gating, chairs, tables, ribbons, signs, etc. The afternoon or evening before the trial, all of those items must be unloaded and distributed around the “Well”.

Whenever our equipment vendor arrives, the members help unload the equipment and set up the rings. When the soccer field is rented for a game or practice the evening of the setup, our members have had to wait until as late as 8 or 9 P.M. to set up the rings. Our fifth annual trial is at our building in October and it is a one ring trial.

The trials usually last from 8 A.M. until around 4 P.M. depending on the number of entries. During the trials at the “Well”, there is a class going on in each of the two rings.

Approximately eight workers are needed for each ring in addition to 2-4 people to work at the scoring table. There are 3-4 classes in each ring per day. Workers are also needed to build courses for each of the three levels in each class. There can be as many as 660 total runs per day. As you can see, it takes a lot of man (and woman) power to run each trial smoothly.

The effort is well worth it as each trial usually nets approximately \$8,000-\$10,000. These help to fund our monthly mortgage payment of \$3,918 for our spacious, new building. Our utilities are around \$1,000 per month. The cost of the insurance is more than the old building, also. Other sources of income for the club are membership dues, class fees and obedience and rally trials.

At our trials the workers’ schedule is always very sparse. We are always short of workers who have committed ahead of time for the various jobs. Therefore, our worker herder,

The worker herders have to scramble at the trial to try to fill in the needed slots. Without the help of exhibitors at the trial, who are not YABTC members, we would never be able to have enough workers to run the trial. Wouldn't it be fantastic if Rae and Bill would be able to start the trial with most of the workers' slots filled in and for them not to have to recruit as many people at the trial? If any of you have even just a few hours on June 20 and 21 and would like to help at the trial, please contact Rae and Bill Reinhart at billrae05@aol.com or agilityworker@yabtc.com.

And if you think that maybe you won't know what to do? Don't worry! None of us did when we first started. We will be happy to teach you right at the trial. Depending on what your skill level is or what activity you would prefer to do, we have a job for you. Workers are compensated with tickets which can be used towards food or vendor items.

Another choice is to use your earnings for credit towards a class at YABTC--agility, rally or obedience. Your club needs your help to make their trials run smoothly and efficiently so that the exhibitors want to come to our trials. There are a lot of trials for them to choose from and we want them to choose YABTC. Please volunteer to help your club to maintain and pay for our wonderful facility!

Please note that this is an actual "sanctioned" match and not just run-thrus.


Trial rules will be applied in the ring (no food, no training, etc.) and scores, placements, and ribbons will be awarded.

The main goal of this seminar is to provide obedience enthusiasts with information and positive reinforcement based training techniques to address the most common questions, problems, and training holes that Laura has seen in her extensive travels giving seminars across the country. Because Laura does not believe that it is possible for anyone to learn a completely new training system in one weekend, in many cases, the games and skills have been selected to compliment your existing training rather than completely replace it. *Topics to be covered include:*

- **Attention!** This is the number one requested seminar topic. How to get and keep attention to you during training and performance, and how to structure your training sessions so that you avoid allowing and inadvertently reinforcing poor attention.
- **Heeling focus and duration:** Improve focus and stretch the time/distance your dog will heel before it gets a reward without losing focus (dog should have been previously introduced to heeling and be able to heel for a few steps in a straight line).
- **Retrieve Hold:** How to improve the hold and eliminate mouthing and dropping of the DB.
- **Drop on Recall:** Using the multiple barrier method to teach or sharpen up your dog's drop on recall.
- **Angle Jump Game:** Introduce taking the jump at an angle for Directed Jumping and proof for bad throws in the Retrieve Over High Jump exercise (does not require a retrieve).
- **Signals:** How to transfer a skill from a verbal command to a signal (or vice versa)
- **Scent Game:** Introduce your dog to searching for an item with your scent. This game is also good to improve the confidence of those dogs already doing articles. Video of the next steps for teaching scent discrimination.
- **Go Out Barrier Touch:** How to teach a paw touch of a barrier for go outs. This can be the foundational method for teaching go outs, or can be added to an existing go out to improve the dog's commitment and willingness to go far enough.
- **Ring Transition:** How to put your trained skills together for a ring performance and maintain motivation under ring conditions (i.e. no food or toys in the ring)

About Laura: For 25 years, Laura Romanik has excelled in competitive obedience, earning hundreds of High in Trials and High Combined awards, national all-breed rankings on several dogs including the Top Obedience Dog of all breeds in 2009, tournament placements and finishing Obedience Trial Championships on three dogs: two Shelties and the first Beagle to be awarded an OTCH. Her Sheltie, Bright earned UDX 20 and over 2300 OTCH points, becoming the first Sheltie to earn both an OTCH and a Herding Championship. Her Sheltie, Flare, is on the top 25 all breed list of lifetime OTCH points with 3,895 points. Flare went from CD to OTCH in just 11 months, all before she was three years old. In 2009, Laura and Flare achieved the prestigious award of Obedience Dog of the Year by accumulating the most OTCH points of any dog in the nation. Laura's current partner, Laser, completed his Novice title with an average score of over 198.5 with 8 High in Trial awards. He also won the Novice Division of the 2014 AKC Obedience Classic Tournament with two scores of 199 and a perfect 200.

In addition to her own success, Laura has a knack for breaking exercises down and explaining her techniques and principles in a straightforward way that others can understand. Laura's students have earned many titles from Rally Novice through OTCH, High in Trial, High Combined awards and National Specialty wins. As an instructor, Laura specializes in taking on the difficult dogs and problems that have resisted improvement elsewhere.

Laura loves obedience training because of the relationship and teamwork that it allows her to develop with her dogs. She uses a training approach that is primarily based on positive reinforcement and built on scientifically recognized behavioral principles. 




