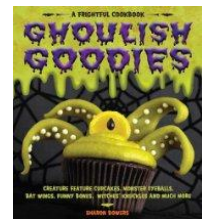

**PUPPY KINDERGARTEN CLASS (FOR PUPPIES 10 – 24 WEEKS OLD) Puppies must have the first two shot series by the second class.** A Bordetella Vaccine is highly recommended Puppy Class is \$80.00 for 6 Weeks
